Join California State School Board Association leaders of color for a virtual panel discussion examining how systemic racism impacts public education.

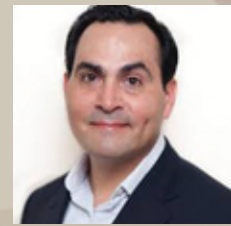

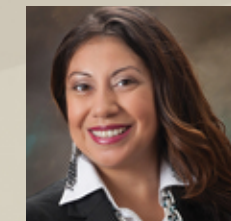
